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Submitting a paper to **Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology Journal**

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The submitted manuscripts will be reviewed for possible publication with the understanding that they have not been published, simultaneously submitted or already accepted for publication elsewhere. The editors will review all submitted manuscripts initially. Manuscripts with insufficient originality, serious scientific flaws, absence of importance of message, or not in according to the requirement of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology Journal (OMPJ) will be rejected. After initial review by editors, the manuscripts will be sent to 2 to 3 expert panel members without revealing the identity of the authors for peer-review. The author for correspondence will be informed about the reviewers' comments and acceptance/rejection of manuscript. Articles accepted may be edited for grammar, punctuation, print style and format. Page proofs will be sent to the author for correspondence through e-mail, which has to be returned within five days to the journal office with corrections, if any. Correction received after that period may not be included in the final print. All manuscripts received/accepted are duly acknowledged. Unaccepted manuscripts will not be returned by the journal office.
